

# Consent for Transition Assessment

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) requires a child with an individualized education plan (IEP) who turns 16 to include:

- (1) Appropriate measurable postsecondary goals based upon age appropriate transition assessments related to training, education, employment, and where appropriate, independent living skills; §300.320(7)(b)(1)

Consent is not required when:

- Reviewing existing data as part of an evaluation or a reevaluation
- Administering a test or other evaluation that is administered to all children, unless, before administration of that test or evaluation, consent is required of parents of all children
  - An assessment is conducted as a routine activity or assignment within the curriculum, and
  - Screening a student to determine appropriate instructional strategies for curriculum implementation. (§300.302)

We will be addressing the following 4 areas: Career/ Employment, Post-secondary Education/ Training, Adult Life, and Community Participation.

All transition assessments require parental consent, or consent of the student who has reached the age of majority.
